

### What is AMDO doing?



Setting a higher standard



Collaborating on processes to keep pets safe



Working groups to ensure effective change in the industry



Events and content to make navigating the microchipping industry easier



A single voice to represent our members



SPoS objective is to streamline the process for authorised users to search and locate pet microchip registrations for fast and effective identification and reunification



Authorised users will be from a range of animal related sectors e.g.

- → Veterinary
- → Law Enforcement
- → Local Authorities and contracted organisations
- → Rescue / Rehoming / Welfare



Roll-out to user groups will be phased with a total estimated user base of 8,000 - 10,000 organisations



Defra estimates delivery in 2025




#### Two-stage process


- Initial lookup of where a microchip is registered
- Return of keeper/pet details

Users must hold an account or be authorised by individual databases to see registration details

#### First request



#### **Second request**





#### SPOS is and does

- Centralised search and lookup tool
- Make identification and reunification quicker
- Provide contact details for the relevant database
- For authorised users



#### SPOS is not and does not

- Single database
- Mean that keeper details are up to date
- > Prevent duplicate registrations
- Always return details
- Allow changes to records
- Allow transfer of keepership
- For public use

### What is AMDO doing?



Responded to consultation with a single voice from AMDO members



Continuing dialogue with Defra



Considering/evaluating potential industry-led solutions to accelerate delivery

### What are the options until SPoS is delivered?

- In the interim, there are existing tools e.g. check-a-chip.co.uk, checkachip.com
- Every compliant database website should have a chip checking tool that tells you where a microchip is registered and provide contact details for the relevant database
- Searchers and pet keepers should never be
   more than two clicks or two phone calls away
   from the information you need
